



Tilt Knobs



Georgian bars & Astragal bars Georgian Bars

- The Georgian Bars are fitted inside the double-glazed panel to give the appearance of smaller panes of glass.
- The bars are installed during the making of the double-glazed panel and sit between the 2 panels of glass within the sealed double-glazed unit.




Georgian bars & Astragal bars Astragal bars

- These bars are fitted to the outside of the double-glazed unit.
- Stands proud of the glass.
- When astragal bars are fitted to a window or door, the sealed glass unit will contain a back-to-back or duplex bar.
- Astragal bars sit on the outside of the glass, replicating the old glazed bar.
